Other Business:

[1] The estimate for the frame for 'The Dream' painting is \$1,495.00 to restore the frame before the wash, \$400.00 extra for the gold leaf wash, plus \$50.00 to rent a van to transport it to Vancouver. The total is \$1,945.00. It was voted to pay for the Gold Leaf wash for \$400.00.

[3] The hats arrived today, 36 black. Doug ordered one dozen pen sets from Ty Morris.

[4] The 1981 girls Basketball State Champions night in November was a huge success.

[5] July 4<sup>th</sup> we have an application to have a booth at the lake for the July 4<sup>th</sup> festivities the 1<sup>st</sup> thru the 4<sup>th</sup>. The fee is \$80.00 for 2006, set up is June 30<sup>th</sup> between 8am and 5pm. Doug will complete the application and send it in. Kim will call Terry Kagle regarding what spot we will get.

[6] Golf Tournament to be discussed in February.

[7] Need to think about tying the Alumni Night and the Hall of Fame together.
